1. Chairman Mike Tennant greeted the attendees and led them in the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance .
2. Chairman Tennant introduced 1st Vice Chairman Carolyn McCorkle.
3. **JD Mesnard:** Carolyn introduced AZ State Senator, JD Mesnard. JD informed us about the bills presently in the legislature. There are bills which are designed to make the elections more reliable. For instance, there is a SB 1485 which would “clean up “ the voter lists of voters who have died or moved away. SB 1713 would require more proof of identity when using a mail in ballot. He also talked about the auditing company which is in charge of the forensic audit of the Presidential ballots from the 2020 election. The auditors are bipartisan. The findings would be to fix “bugs” in the system before the 2022 election. The results would not change the results of the 2020 election but they might restore confidence in our elections. JD also talked about the Governor who requested the National Guard to go to our southern border to restore order.
4. **Dan Farley:** Carolyn introduced Dan Farley. Dan Farley shared his personal journey in becoming the President of The Phoenix Tea Party Patriots and inspired us to get involved & stay connected to Keep American First. Dan Farley shared and explained the tools he has created on an Excel spreadsheet and offered copies of his extensive network of resources.
5. **Susan Kay Schultz:** Carolyn introduced Susan Kay Schultz . Susan Kay Schultz informed and taught us how we can make a difference by joining the Republican Party Network: Keeping the American People First! The name of the network Yale Wishnick

has helped create is called: “Republican Party Network (RPN)”. The plan was to create a way for like minded Republicans to have direct and immediate access to each other in a highly energized and interactive community made up of workshops, courses, expert speakers, events, conferences, posting, coaching national meetings and so on.
